ATTENDING LENNOX THEATRE AT RIVERSIDE THEATRES

You are going to see at theatre show at Riverside Theatres in Parramatta. There are signs out the front saying 'Riverside'.

EDUCATION

You will need a ticket to see your show. If you haven't got a ticket, when you arrive you will need to go to the Box Office to get your ticket. You might need to wait in a line.



Before the show starts, you might need to wait in the foyer. The foyer is where you wait with your family or friends until the performance starts.

Or you could wait in the courtyard.



EDUCATION

While you are waiting, you might need to go to the bathroom. Don't worry - there are bathrooms there for you to use.



The show you are seeing is on in the Lennox Theatre. There is a sign out the front of the Lennox Theatre with a number 5.



An usher will meet you and tell you when it's time to go inside. Then you will go inside with your class.



Inside the theatre there are red seats. Your teacher or an usher will tell you which seat to sit in.



When the show starts, it will be time to be quiet and listen. The lights will turn down a little bit- but it will not go too dark so don't worry.

EDUCATION

You will be seeing a theatre show, not a movie. There will be real people on stage. They are called the performers. They might play music, sing, dance or tell you a story. They might wear costumes or make-up. This helps them tell us the story.



When the show is finished, people will clap their hands.

This is to thank the performers. You can clap too if you want to, or if it is too loud you can put your hands over your ears.



EDUCATION

When the performance is finished, you will leave Riverside.

You will leave through the sliding doors again.



It's great fun to go to the theatre!

Near Riverside Theatres there is the river to walk or sit beside. Prince Alfred Park is also just around the corner.
